HOUSTON (April 15, 2014) - An Iraqi trade ministry delegation tour of <u>Mobil</u> <u>Steel International, Inc.</u> resulted in high praise for the Houston-based AISC quality certified steel fabricator. The Iraqi delegation witnessed Mobil Steel's set up for an Iraqi project.
